



Market Updates
Week of 6/19/17

- Poultry---** Chicken market is leveling off in a strong market. Wings is down very slightly, Breast and Thighs are steady and Tenders are higher.
- Turkey---** Market is stable. Ask your sales rep about our Plainville all natural line of turkey and chicken products.
- Beef---** Live cattle market is steady this week. Heavy demand and thin supply is keeping most cuts in a strong market. This strong market is expected to remain thru July. Briskets and Strips are up. The Rib complex is higher with very short supply. Grinds are sharply higher. Tenders are steady. Rounds are steady. Top butts are steady. Short Ribs are slightly up as well. Flat meats are steady while Loins are down.
- Pork----** The Pork market is up sharply this week. Strong demand, increase export activity, and the high beef market is driving pork higher. Bacon is up this week. Loins complex is up. Butts, and Trim meats are also up. Hams are steady. Rib complex seems to be steady

Please check all produce at delivery. Check with your sales rep with further questions or concerns. West Coast produce is looking good. East Coast is being effected by some wet weather. Some GAP issues moving up the east coast are still being felt. **Greens---** are steady this week, but look for some higher pricing going into next week *****Apples**— New York State Apples are done for the year until the fall, look for more apple coming out of the west coast with limited variety. ****Asparagus**— out of Mexican region is steady this week. ****Avocado** out of Mexico is very strong but with some added product out of California has eased the market slightly resulting in some slightly lower pricing. ** **Peppers** are strong with higher pricing due to weather related problem ****Cabbage**— Look for steady pricing as increase supply, heads are getting heavy ****Berry market**— Blackberries, and Raspberries are steady. Strawberries out of Calif. Good quality. ****Broccoli**— is showing a more stable market...pricing is down. ** **Cauliflower**— is getting better as well with lower prices ** **Cucumbers**— are showing some lower pricing.*** **Green beans**— are local with good value. ****Tomatoes**— are all looking steady. ****Potatoes** No Chefs in the market due to GAP issues until new crop is in the market . Consider Red A Pota. Look for higher pricing due to strong demand ****Citrus**— is on the rise on the Orange market as we are seeing the end of navels. **Lemons are strong with small sizes **Limes are looking strong as well. ****Squash**—is are also on the rise. ****Melons**— are steady. ****Watermelons**— more supply in the market is driving the price lower ****Eggplant**— are strong with higher pricing. ****Onions**— new crop is in ****Grapes**— are steady, look for a higher pricing going into next week. ****Carrots**— are steady coming

out of Calif. **Celery**— better supply look for lower pricing **Cilantro**— has stabilized and showing good supply. **Garlic**— is up in a strong market. **Sweet corn**—coming from Florida. **Stone Fruit**— Look for more items coming available in the next few weeks, Parsley is up sharply this week.

Dairy/ cheese--The Market is lower this week.

Butter is much higher this week due to export.

Heavy Cream is up as well.

Liquid products, Milk, cream, etc, is expected to be high into July due to seasonal demand.

Grains/soy/Flour---- The Flour market is looking at a strong market....Look for pricing to rise.

Soy Market — Looks to be steady this week. Look for this market to be slightly lower in weeks to come.

Sugar--- We are seeing a strong market in the Sugar futures do to the issues in Mexico once again. Look for some higher pricing.

Eggs— Egg market is steady this week...look for this market to be up and down as farmer are reducing flocks. We are seeing some shortages and supply issues with large eggs.

Non Foods-- Supplier's of ALL products have announced a price increase due to raw products. May is the month that we expected to see the prices would rise.

Seafood--- Cod and Haddock is slightly higher
